"The Justice Jamboree brings voices of change together with decision makers while using the power of the "voter" as a catalyst for change," says Vanessa Perez, Assoc. We are so excited that Governor Jerry Brown has received a special invitation from our state legislators to attend our local event and further raise the awareness about the local needs for statewide resources.

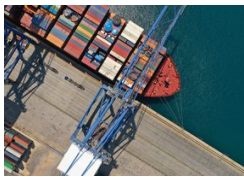
