Time for Change Foundation founder honored as Remarkable Woman of the Year

Kim Carter-Tillman, founder and executive director of the San Bernardino-based Time for Change Foundation, was named national Remarkable Woman of the Year this spring, in Nexstar Media Group's 2025 Remarkable Women program.

The program recognizes women who have made a difference in public policy, social progress and the quality of life in their communities, according to a news release.

Carter-Tillman, who represented KTLA as its local finalist, joined 124 other women from across the nation in a Hollywood experience that included a visit to Warner Bros. Studios, where the finalists were invited as special guests to "The Jennifer Hudson Show," according to the news release.

The 125 Remarkable Women finalists were selected from more than 200 Nexstar Media Group-owned or partner stations across 116 U.S. markets.

Carter-Tillman was first selected as one of the five regional finalists, each of whom received \$5,000 toward a charity of her choice. As the national Remarkable Woman of the Year, she received \$25,000 from the Nexstar Charitable Foundation for her designated charity, according to the news release.

The announcement was made during a one-hour "Remarkable Women" special that aired in April on The CW Network.

In addition to being the founder of Time for Change Foundation, Carter-Tillman is co-founder and president of the Black and Brown Opportunities for Profit Center and president and chief executive officer of the Center for Housing Advancement and Motivational Projects.

Her work focuses on transforming societal approaches to marginalized women through entrepreneurial empowerment models, according to the news release.
