Master of Ceremonies **Giselle Fernandez** kicked off the evening of awards, presentations, and recognition. The reception and red carpet will be followed by the awards ceremony and a seated dinner, concluding with an exclusive private tour of the museum.

Renowned Italian artist **Camilla Ancilotto** designed the Victoria Award that was presented to the honorees. Inspired by the ancient Winged Victory of Vani (2nd–1st century BC), the bronze statuette symbolizes light and rebirth, featuring restored gold-plated wings while preserving the aged bronze as a tribute to its origins. Each piece was crafted by Poignée, the esteemed Italian workshop known for creating the papal coats of arms for Popes Benedict XVI, Francis, and Leo.
